College Aid Guidelines

1. Applicants must be a member of Zion Lutheran Church for a minimum of one year.
2. Applicants must be graduating from high school and be accepted to an accredited college which they will be attending full time (minimum 12 credits).
3. Applicants must be active participants in worship; one who worships and communes regularly.
4. Applicants must be a participant in at least one aspect of the life of Zion; i.e. usher, reader, Apple Harvest Festival, choir, senior youth group, Sunday School, or VBS volunteer.
5. It is preferred that the applicants be involved in senior youth activities; i.e. Breakfast Club, Teen discussions, and fundraising (spring/fall cleanup, bake sales, bottle drives, etc.)
6. Applications must be accompanied by an essay (minimum one page typed). One of the following should be addressed:
 - a. Describe your relationship with God.
 - b. What does the Lutheran Church mean to you and how has it enriched your faith in God?
 - c. How has your involvement as a member of Zion Lutheran Church impacted your contribution to society?
7. Applications and essays must be submitted to Zion Lutheran Church, Attention: Director of Christian Welfare, by April 1, 2009. Essays will be reviewed and submitted to Pastor Debner for final selection.
