A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Community of Zion,

This is my annual letter where I step up onto my Christmas soapbox. It started years ago when someone told me they were too busy celebrating Christmas to come to worship on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day. Please note, this is not about shaming!!!!! This is about finding opportunity.

Since that person said that to me, I've tried to get people to look at Christmas in two ways. There is Christmas (the gift exchange and parties) and Christmas (the Nativity of Our Lord aka the birth of Jesus, God coming into the world). Sometimes, maybe even more often, the first gets in the way of the second.

To be fair, secular celebrations of the winter solstice and the light were around before celebrating the birth of Jesus ("They were here first"). Have You Noticed? There's So Much Going on Around the Grounds of the Church!

- -The large hedges by Pastor's driveway were cut down to make a better site line onto Pleasant Street.
