A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Community of Zion,

Christmas Eve 2020.....my first Christmas Eve at Zion. I was in the doorway (the blue door in the back). The worship assistant (Dean) was at the bottom of the stairs. The sound guy (Bill) was at the top of the stairs. The Messner family was in the library with microphones. The Holbrooks were in the sanctuary, also with microphones. John Miller was somewhere in between or maybe everywhere. The congregation was in cars in the parking lot. I said later that it was my favorite Christmas Eve. Not because of the way we worshipped (although it was a little closer to being at the manger, then the usual pomp of Christmas Eve). But because how it came together. The planning, the setting up, the participants, the cleaning up afterwards. People took initiative and did want needed to be done.

Christmas Eve 2024, 2:50 pm......it was clear that there was going to be more people at worship than we had planned for (about twice as many people as the previous year). Not enough enough seats, not enough communion. But in those ten minutes before worship, people set up chairs, the Gathering Place was rearranged as overflow, and two additional people were recruited to help with communion....and worship went off without a hitch. Christmas Eve 2024 is now tied with 2020 as my favorite Christmas Eve. Not because of the way we worshipped. But because of how everyone was involved. Thank you to the people: who decorated the sanctuary, who put together the bulletins, who planned the worship, who led the music, who filled the candles, who assisted with the service, who set up and took down chairs and the Gathering Place and helped in ways I didn't see.

The people of Zion sure know how to pitch in and work together.
